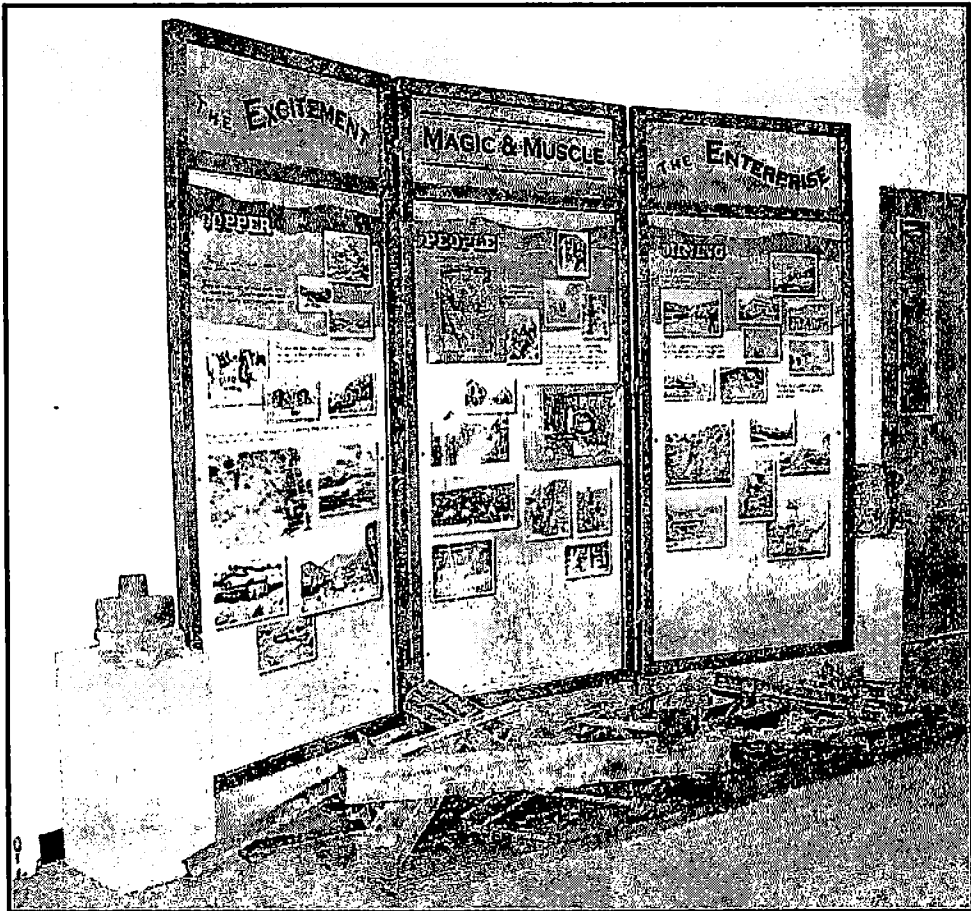


Bullion Plaza Cultural Center and Museum

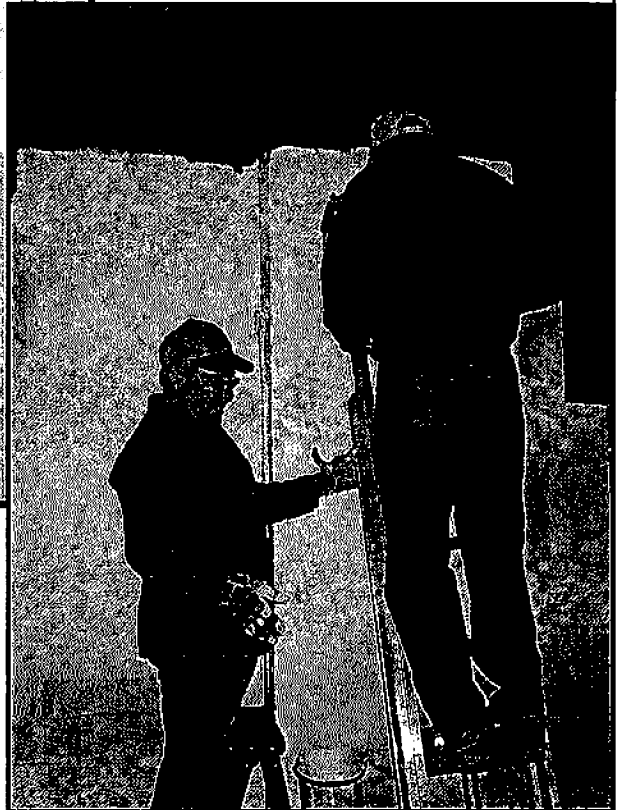

MOFFORD PORTRAIT DONATED TO BULLION PLAZA

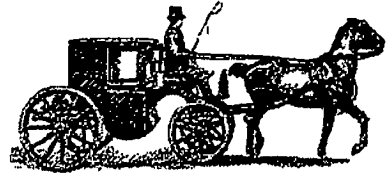
